CANADA 90' BRIDGE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, to enable essential engineering work, the Canada 90' Bridge will be opened and remain in its open position during the following period:

28 July 2024

08.00 to 16.00

During this period, the following points must be considered:

- 1. Prior to passing through the bridge passageway, masters of vessels must obtain permission to do so from the Langton Dockmaster on VHF Ch.21.
- Vessels must pass the bridge at minimum safe speed through the water to avoid putting wash into the bridge recess where personnel will be working.
- 3. The workboat *Forth Hunter* will be operating in the area of the bridge transporting foot passengers between the east and west sides the docks.
- 4. Vessels inward- or outward-bound via Langton Lock and requiring mooring services must confirm with their mooring service provider on which side of Langton Lock they will be attending.

Unless notice is given to the contrary, this Notice will be withdrawn at 16.00 on 28 July 2024.
