## Approaches to Sheerness SS Richard Montgomery Wreck – Hydrographic Survey Work

**Notice is hereby given** that survey work is due to take place around the wreck of the SS Richard Montgomery, the SS Richard Montgomery is a designated dangerous wreck under section 2 of the Protection of Wrecks Act 1973 and there is a no-entry exclusion zone around the wreck, the co-ordinates of which are published in Statutory Instrument 1973 No 1690. Section 3 of the Act makes entry into the prohibited area an offence without the written permission of the Secretary of State.

Survey work is due to commence on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> September 2024 (outside of the exclusion zone) with completion expected by <u>26<sup>th</sup> September 2024</u>. The survey vessel "**Lode**" will be conducting the survey and has been granted permission to enter the prohibited area for the purposes of carrying out a survey of the wreck and the immediate area of seabed surrounding the wreck. Permission to enter the prohibited area of the wreck is approved from 17<sup>th</sup> September 2024 and extends to 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2024.



Whilst surveying, "Lode" will be restricted in it's ability to manoeuvre and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch.74 at all times, <u>all vessels are requested to pass with caution and reduce</u> <u>speed and wash appropriately.</u>
