

NOTICE TO MARINERS No 62/24

RIVER CLYDE – CONSTRUCTION OF GOVAN TO PARTICK FOOTBRIDGE

Mariners are advised that works associated with building a new opening footbridge across the River Clyde between Govan and Partick are ongoing. The south pier is complete and the bridge span is installed in the open position. Works to complete the north pier will continue until approximately September 2024. The green circles on the drawing below indicate the locations of the bridge piers. A safety boat is in operation to support the works as required. Mariners should note that there may be a requirement for divers to support this project from time-to-time. Works are being conducted from CW6 barge which has been moved to a position perpendicular to the north pier. It will remain in this position until approximately the end of July 2024.

Mariners are requested to navigate with caution in this area and pass the construction site at appropriate speed.
