

INCIDENT REPORTING

Mariners are advised that any marine incident or near miss must be reported to Clydeport. This can be done by use of the Marine Incident Report Form which is available to download at:

NAVIGATIONAL AIDS

Any defect or damage observed to navigational aids should be reported to Estuary Radio on VHF Ch12 or 0151-949 6651.

Mariners are reminded that mooring to floating Aids to Navigation is strictly prohibited as obstruction and or damage to the AtoN and its mooring or cause it to break free of its charted position. This can create a danger to life and a hazard to the safety of navigation.

As an IALA AtoN, buoys mark navigational channels. Persons whose vessel is found to be moored to any floating AtoN within Clydeport jurisdiction will be subject to enforcement action.
