Approaches to Sheerness SS Richard Montgomery Wreck – Hydrographic Survey Work

Notice is hereby given that survey work is due to take place around the wreck of the SS Richard Montgomery, the SS Richard Montgomery is a designated dangerous wreck under section 2 of the Protection of Wrecks Act 1973 and there is a no-entry exclusion zone around the wreck, the coordinates of which are published in Statutory Instrument 1973 No 1690. Section 3 of the Act makes entry into the prohibited area an offence without the written permission of the Secretary of State.

Survey work is due to commence on Monday 16th September 2024 (outside of the exclusion zone) with completion expected by 23rd September 2024. The survey vessel "**Lode**" will be conducting the survey and has been granted permission to enter the prohibited area for the purposes of carrying out a survey of the wreck and the immediate area of seabed surrounding the wreck. Permission to enter the prohibited area of the wreck is approved from 17th September 2024 and extends to 23rd September 2024.



Whilst surveying, "Lode" will be restricted in it's ability to manoeuvre and will maintain a listening watch on VHF Ch.74 at all times, <u>all vessels are requested to pass with caution and reduce speed and wash appropriately.</u>
